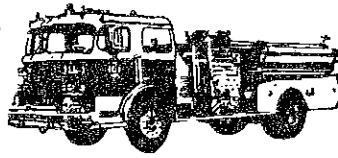

The enclosed report will reflect the activities of the Mack Fire Department for the year of 1981.

Earlier in the year, we took delivery of the 100' Aerial Tower which had been ordered two (2) years previously.

A new body for the heavy rescue unit was ordered with an anticipated delivery in the early spring of 1982.

A new E.M.S. vehicle was purchased and delivered in early summer. We now have four complete Paramedic Units to serve our community.

An additional two (2) men were added to the full-time staff, this fulfilled the paid personnel promised to the residents of Green Township when the tax levy was passed in 1980. This brought our full-time strength to nine (9) firemen and the Chief.

The Fire Prevention Division was busy with inspections, tours, and plan reviews.

I wish to extend my personal thanks and that of the entire Department to the Board of Trustees for their cooperation in the past year and also to thank the residents of Green Township for their continued support of our endeavors to provide for the Fire and Life Safety of our community.

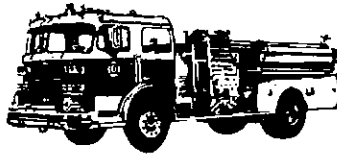

TRAINING

A 36-hour Basic Training Course was completed by 13 recruits. This is mandatory by State Law. All other firemen are enrolled in a continuing education in order to meet state requirements.

State Fire School was attended by Lt. Mike DiMuzio, Fire Fighters Jim Eckhoff, Mike Herbert, Dave Lupp, and Don Zang. This instruction is held over a five (5) day period totalling forty (40) hours.

Marshall Bud Zorb and Fire Fighter Frank Sutton attended an N.F.P.A. Fire Ground Commander course taught at the University of Cincinnati.

A management course was taught by Dr. Sam Mantel of the University of Cincinnati, to all Fire Officers of the Fire Department including officers of the Green Township Police Department.

Tom Dietz, Tom Elsbernd, and Mark Wagner completed a 200 hour Fire School at the State Fire Academy, a requirement for all full-time fire fighters.

Marshall Bud Zorb and Fire Fighter Ed Thomas attended Fire Department Instructor's Conference in Memphis, Tennessee.

Assistant Chief Sweeney taught a 27-hour refresher course to Mack Firemen. Lt. Ruberg taught a 78-hour EMT course and Karol Huber also taught a 78-hour EMT course.

CPR classes were taught throughout the Township as a community service by members of the Department.

Lt. Ruberg and Frank Sutton spoke to students at Oak Hills High School for "Career Day."

A baby sitting course was taught at both Fire Head Quarters and District 20 for teenage children, by Captains Rutenschroer, Sweeney, Seng, and Weghorst.

Tours and demonstrations were conducted throughout the year for the schools and scout groups by all the full-time personnel.

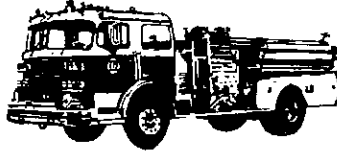

Western Hamilton County Firemens' Association meeting was attended by Chief Weitzel, Marshall Zorb, and Lieutenant Rack.

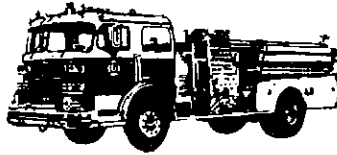

FIRE PREVENTION DIVISION

In the year of 1981, the office reviewed 45 sets of plans for new construction. Twenty (20) of those have been completed and given final approval of occupancy. Nine (9) permits have been finalled for alterations. Three (3) permits were issued for repair on gasoline tanks.

For the year, there were thirty-two (32) final approvals leaving thirteen (13) open permits.

Numerous fire safety inspections were made on existing buildings throughout the Township by both full-time and part-time inspectors. Schools and large businesses were the prime concern. Other projects have been started, such as, marking fire lanes on schools, churches, and shopping centers.

We have inspected many wood stove installations in private residences.

The Investigation Division spent many hours on serveral fires which were listed as arson or suspicious. Many thanks to the men who helped with the investigations which led to the apprehension of suspects in the cases.

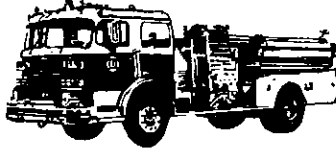

In an effort to provide better fire protection to the Township, many new fire hydrants were added in 1981. These areas had water mains but lacked hydrants. Some of the major areas that were up-dated include: North Bend Road, between Westwood Northern Blvd. and I-74, Cleves Warsaw, Glenway Avenue, West Fork Road, and Rubel Place.

Again this year, we covered most of the Township with our Hydrant Maintenance program. This program consists of flushing the hydrant, greasing the hydrant valve and cap threads, and pumping the excess water from the hydrant barrel. Within the past two (2) years, all hydrants in the Township have been completed and most have been done twice.

This year we have also begun to paint hydrants using yellow for the barrels and fluorescent white for the tops, enabling the driver to spot the hydrant easier during night time hours.

We have been working closely with Hamilton County Maintenance Department, when a hydrant is out of service beyond our maintenance capabilities, and have received very good service from them.

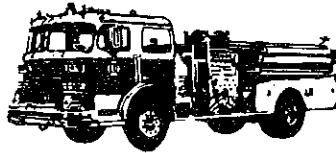

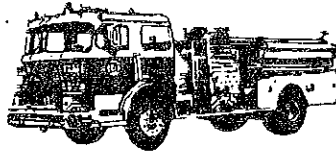

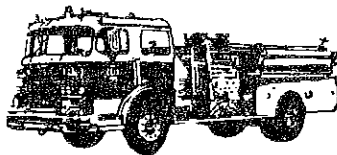
